

MAINTENANCE TECHNICIAN

POSITION DEFINITION

Under the general direction of the General Manager or his designate, performs duties as a member of the maintenance crew related to the installation and maintenance of water distribution and sewer collection systems in RSA's service area. Work may include water plant and wastewater plant maintenance, and RSA equipment maintenance. The technician may be exposed to extreme environmental conditions such as heat, cold, and rain, and may be required to work overtime hours at night and on weekends. The maintenance technician would be responsible for responding to emergency calls after hours and be included in an on-call rotation.

TYPICAL EXAMPLES OF DUTIES

The technician is expected to become fully competent within a short period, of all phases of the installation and maintenance of all systems mentioned above which can be accomplished using hand tools and power and electrical tools. The technician is required to become familiar with all systems and all other appurtenances. Performs other duties as assigned.

QUALIFICATIONS

Education and Experience: Education equivalent to graduation from high school or vocational school.

Knowledge and Abilities: The working conditions require the technician to be in good physical condition and be able to complete all above tasks efficiently. Knowledge of maintenance techniques and mechanics helpful. Must possess and maintain a valid Virginia driver's license.
